The cattlemen participated in 16 Farm/Ag days in 2019. Over 7,000 students learned about beef, beef by-products, beef nutrition, and where their food comes from.

Activity books or coloring books were given to the students and cookbooks were given to the teachers. All materials were provided by the Georgia Beef Board which helped the cattlemen make these Farm/Ag days a success.

During the GCWA's annual meeting last year, the GCWA Scholarship was awarded to Eryn Elliot.

At the Georgia Junior Beef Futurity in July, the cattlemen provided belt buckles for showmanship awards to the 4th- 12th grade winners.
